Touring Road Rally: A touring road rally is a time-speed-distance (TSD) motoring event requiring navigation skills as well as driving ability. Competitors must determine their proper time of arrival at various points along a common route over public roads according to a set of precise written route instructions. Using the relationships of distance, speed, and time to calculate their progress while keeping to assigned legal speeds, success is measured by arrival at the destination point being neither early or late, for a perfect time.

THE SOUTHWEST QUADRANT

From Menomonie go south on Broadway/Hwy. 25, right on Hwy. 29W to Riverside Park. The park has plenty of parking and is a great place to meet up. Beginning at Riverside Park, this rally will take you west of Menomonie on Hwy 29, by the head of the famed Red Cedar Trail.

Next to the trail is Rustic Road #89 which is the only rustic road in Dunn County. It is also called the "Irvington Autobahn" by the locals but watch your speed as the area is patrolled and there are some surprising corners. This will lead you past the Devil's Punch Bowl Scientific Study area and Paradise Valley. You will end in downtown Downsville where there are fun pubs and eateries to suit all tastes.
